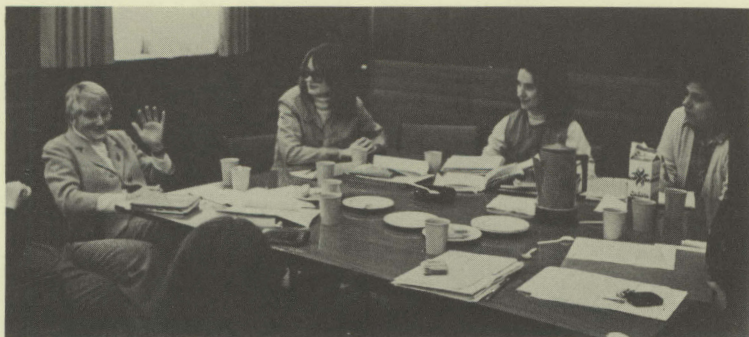


Women's Liberation
